Abdelmalek Essaadi University stands out in its second participation in the prestigious ranking system

"Times Higher Education - Impact Rankings 2023"

Abdelmalek Essaadi University (UAE) is proud to be included for the second time in the international ranking "Times Higher Education - Impact Rankings 2023", which assesses the ability of universities around the world to meet the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

For its second participation, UAE participated in 8 SDGs and was distinguished in 3, namely SDG 6 "Clean water and sanitation", which aims for universal and equitable access to drinking water, hygiene and sanitation; SDG 14 "Life below water", which promotes the conservation and sustainable use of marine and coastal ecosystems and SDG 15 "Life on land", which promotes the preservation and restoration of terrestrial ecosystems.

- For SDG 6 "Clean Water and Sanitation", UAE ranks first at the national level and ranks 201-300 internationally.
- For SDG 14 "Life below water", UAE occupies the first place at the national level and ranks 201-300 internationally.
- -For SDG 15 "Life on land", UAE occupies the first place at the national level and ranks 201-300 internationally.

UAE's participation in this ranking strengthens the position and visibility of Moroccan universities internationally. It shows their commitment as responsible institutions, acting positively for the society by responding as best as possible to the objectives of the United Nations; and by aligning with the national strategy undertaken by Morocco for Sustainable Development.
